2. The world’s population went over 6 billion in 1999. What is the estimate for the world's population in 2050?

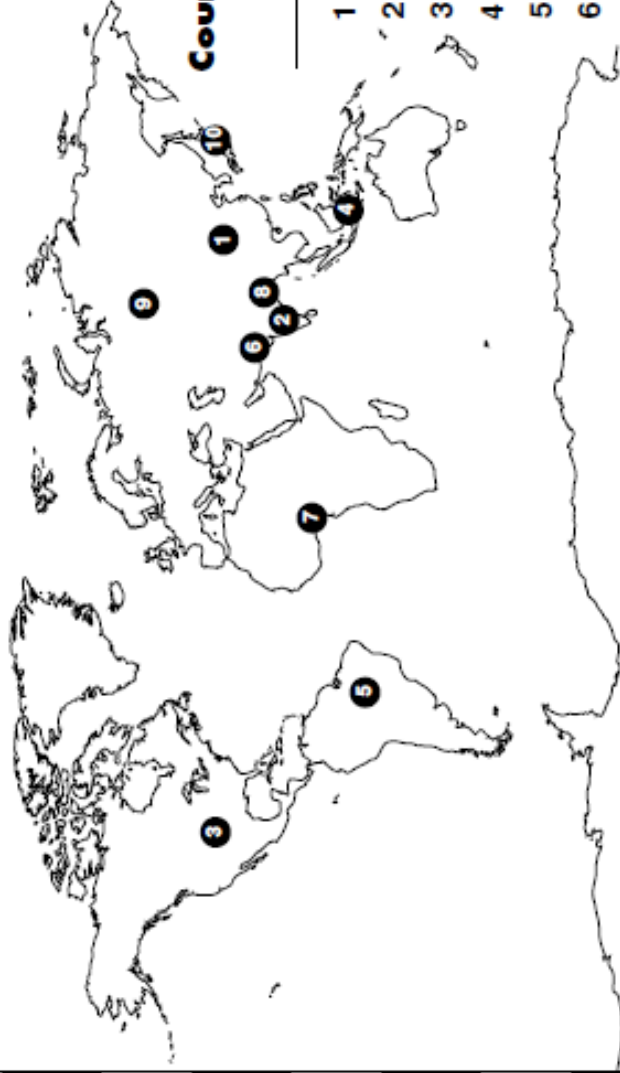
### Friday:
